

St. Michael's Tuition Credit Referral Program Q&A

What is the Purpose of the Program?

The purpose of the Program is to enroll new families in St. Michael the Archangel's day school.

What are the Terms of the Program?

A \$500 tuition credit will be granted for each successful referral of a new family that enrolls in grades K-8 of St. Michael the Archangel School. The credit is transferrable: it can be applied to any family attending St. Michael's day school.

Example #1: Parishioner A refers Family Z to St. Michael's school. Family Z enrolls in the school. Parishioner A can have the \$500 tuition credit applied to Family Z's tuition.

Example #2: Family B has a student attending St. Michael's school. Family B refers Family Y to St. Michael's school. Family Y enrolls in the school. Family B can either have the tuition credit applied to the tuition of Family B or Family Y.

What Criteria Defines a New Family?

A "new family" is one that has (i) never had a child enrolled at St. Michael's day school or (ii) not had a child enrolled in St. Michael's day school for past two years. Families living inside or outside St. Michael's boundaries are eligible.

Who is Eligible To Refer New Families and Receive the Tuition Credit?

All (i) registered St. Michael parishioners and (ii) families with children currently enrolled in St. Michael's school are eligible to refer new families and receive the tuition credit. Employees of St. Michael's are not eligible to receive the credit.

Is There a Cap on the Number of Referrals/Tuition Credits?

There is no limit in the number of referrals and subsequent tuition credits that can be made or earned by a parishioner or family. Potentially, a family's total amount of tuition could be covered by tuition credits.

How Can the Tuition Credit be Used?

The \$500 credit will be applied to the designated family's tuition. It cannot be used for registration or book fees.

How Can the Credit be Claimed?

Simply go to St. Michael's website (www.stmike.org) or the church office to get a form. After the form has been completed and signed by both the referring parishioner/school family and the new family, it should be returned to the church office. The credit will be applied after the new family's registration payment/tuition commitment has been received by the church or school office.
